— Treaties and Agreements —

Multilateral:

Protocol Amending the Agreement on Government Procurement, accepted on September 28, 1987, entered into force on February 14, 1988.

Convention Establishing the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency, instrument of acceptance deposited on June 5, 1987, entered into force on April 12, 1988.

Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, instrument of accession deposited on October 28, 1988, entered into force with respect to Japan on November 27, 1988.

Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer, instrument of accession deposited on September 30, 1988, entered into force with respect to Japan on December 29, 1988.

Montreal Protocol on Substances That Deplete the Ozone Layer, instrument of acceptance deposited on September 30, 1988, entered into force on January 1, 1989.

Bilateral:

Headquarters Agreement between the Government of Japan and the International Tropical Timber Organization, exchange of notes made on May 27, 1988, entered into force on May 27, 1988.

Protocol Amending the Agreement between Japan and the United States of America concerning Special Measures Relating to Article XXIV of the Agreement Under Article VI of the Treaty of Mutual Cooperation and Security between Japan and the United States of America, Regarding Facilities and Areas and the Status of United States Armed Forces in Japan, signed on March 2, 1988, exchange of notes made on June 1, 1988, entered into force on June 1, 1988.

Agreement for Cooperation between the Government of Japan

and the Government of the United States of America Concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy, signed on November 4, 1987, exchange of notes made on June 17, 1988, entered into force on July 17, 1988.
