Multilateral:

Agreement Establishing the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, accepted on April 2, 1991, entered into force on the same day.

International Agreement on Jute and Jute Products, accepted on April 26, 1991.

Bilateral:

Agreement between Japan and the United States of America concerning New Special Measures Relating to Article XXIV of the Agreement under Article VI of the Treaty of Mutual Cooperation and Security between Japan and the United States of America, Relating Facilities and Areas and the Status of United States Armed Forces in Japan, accepted on April 17, 1991, entered into force on the same day.
